2019 was an incredible year for REVIVED, with 163 participants recruited from 29 different sites, by far our best year to date.

It is a very exciting time in REVIVED as we enter the final few months of recruitment. We now have only 34 participants left to recruit. It is important to work up those last few potential patients as soon as possible to ensure they can enter the study before we reach our target.

We will keep you all posted as we countdown to participant no. 700.



Our recruitment rate over 2019 was 13.5 participants per month. If we continue recruiting at this rate, we could reach our target in March.



Screensaver poster



If the intervention may affect our outcomes (e.g. mortality, hospitalisation due to heart failure), or is too burdensome for the patient, then they cannot be co-enrolled

Getting to know you - Newcastle's (Freeman) REVIVED Team

Freeman Hospital in Newcastle opened to recruitment in 2014 and have recruited 25 participants. They have been a big part of REVIVED's recent success - 2019 was their best year so far with 9 participants recruited. We wanted to know a bit more about the team and how the trial works at their site.

How REVIVED works at Newcastle

The REVIVED Research Study Team is a multidisciplinary team (MDT), working together to try and contribute to the study as much as possible. We identify patients by screening the wards on a daily basis, reviewing cardiac MRI results and being available to clinicians that see heart failure in outpatients. We do this through reviewing patients' electronic records and discussing cases in the multidisciplinary care team before we make any decision.

Patients identified as eligible by the consultants will be discussed at our MDT meeting. If the patient is a suitable candidate for the trial, then we approach them when they attend for their outpatient appointments or send out the study patient information sheet to them. In clinic, they are introduced to the study research nurses and are provided with a patient information sheet. We discuss the trial with the patient and any relatives present to make sure they have all the information they need and all the support they require to make an informed decision that is best for them. The trial recruitment is driven mainly by Dr Edwards and Dr McDiarmid.
