REVIVED passed a huge milestone this month with the **350th patient** randomised, which means we are halfway to the planned target of 700. This comes almost four years to the day after the first patient was recruited into the trial. REVIVED has come a long way since then, the recruitment rate has steadily risen and we are now well on track to complete recruitment in time.

In total 6 patients were recruited in August, from 6 different sites.

We will be sending a thank you gift to all six sites that recruited a patient in August.

New sites

A site initiation is pencilled in for Derriford Hospital in Plymouth, this will be the 35th site opened for REVIVED.

With the cost extension secured we plan to open at least five additional sites in the coming months.

There has been interest from Ninewells Hospital in Dundee, Blackpool Victoria Hospital, Bristol Royal Infirmary, Wythenshawe Hospital in Manchester, Royal Berkshire Hospital in Reading and St George's Hospital in London.
