

How REVIVED works at Bristol

We use a multidisciplinary team approach for recruitment. We rely on referrals from the heart failure team and our interventional colleagues, who flag patients at the multidisciplinary team meetings every week. We are very privileged to have a very proactive PI who also identifies potential participants he sees in his clinic.

Everybody is on board! Team work and being embedded within the clinical team are key for successful recruitment.

For the follow-up, we all work together as a team: the PI, our Research Fellow and the nurses, making sure everything is done properly. It is a real team effort!
